

ORIENTATION

Undergraduate Students

All new undergraduate students, including freshmen, freshmen-transfer (1 to 29 credit hours earned), or transfer (30 or more credit hours earned), are required to complete online orientation to fulfill their new student orientation requirement. In addition to the online orientation requirement, The Office of Orientation and Family Programs (<https://future.utsa.edu/orientation/>) facilitates optional in-person orientation experiences that afford students the opportunity to learn about campus services, resources, and student life along with Roadrunner spirit and traditions. UTSA Family Orientation, offered both as an optional in-person or virtual experience, gives family members an introduction to UTSA by focusing on student academic success and student life.

Graduate Students

Graduate School Orientation provides the opportunity for new graduate students to receive an overview of how to succeed in graduate school, including the resources and services available to them.
